CLASSES

- Kindergarten** - Ages 3½ to 6, exposure to Chinese, beginning writing and pronunciation, yet geared for fun. **\$5 material fee, payable to teacher on first day of class.**
- Pin Ying I** – Beginning Chinese, emphasis on pronunciation, textbook 1, requires homework.
- Pin Ying II** – Textbook 2, assumes basic knowledge of Pin Ying system and pronunciation, 200 characters, simple conversation, requires homework.
- Pin Ying III** – Textbook 3, assumes basic knowledge of Pin Ying system and pronunciation, 300 characters, simple conversations, requires homework.
- Pin Ying IV** – Textbook 4, assumes basic knowledge of Pin Ying system and pronunciation, 400 characters, simple conversations, requires homework.
- Pin Ying V** – Textbook 5, assumes basic knowledge of Pin Ying system and pronunciation, 500 characters, simple conversations, requires homework.
- High School Credit** – Requires two hours of one of the other classes plus one hour of enrichment class per week.
- Conversational Class** – Concentration on conversation, oriented to the needs of people traveling in Chinese-speaking countries.
